Annexation Resident Information

Newly annexed areas can access City services that are available to all residents including:

- Police protection
- Fire protection
- Emergency medical services
- Solid waste collection services
- Libraries
- Access to Parks and Recreations facilities, including recreation centers, senior centers, pools and tennis centers
- Services from the City of Corpus Christi-Nueces County Health District
- 1. A four-year plan will be created to provide other City services not currently available to the newly annexed area.
- 2. Within four years the City will provide water and wastewater services.
- 3. The owners and inhabitants are entitled to all rights, privileges, and burdens of other citizens and property owners of the City and are subject to and bound by the city charter, ordinances, resolutions, and rules including the Unified Development Code, building codes, nuisance regulations, animal control, and general health and sanitation regulations.
- 4. The newly annexed property is designated with an initial zoning designation per the Unified Development Code 4.5.1 Newly Annexed Territory of "FR" Farm Rural District.
- 5. The residents are in City Council District 5.
- 6. Residents of the newly annexed areas are not eligible to vote in the November 4, 2014, City Council or Bond proposition election. (Sec. 276.006, Election Code).
