CASH

During a hurricane, there will be power outages. Credit cards will not be accepted in businesses and ATM's will not work. Make sure you have enough cash handy.



GAS

Long lines to get gas are expected during an evacuation. Gas stations may close if there are no employees available. Have containers with fresh gas once a storm approaches the area.



SHIPMENTS

Survival kits and other gadgets may be difficult to get. Overnight shipments can be pricey if you wait to order a specific item at the last minute.



MEDICATIONS

Pharmacies will be busy filling prescriptions. Some may close. Not all insurance companies cover all medications. Make sure you have at least a months' supply ready.



TRAINING

CPR comes in handy during an emergency. If you wait to learn, there might not be classes available during the time of an emergency. Check with the local Red Cross for classes.



AUTOMOBILE

Just like in any long distance road trip, from oil checks to reliable tires, your vehicle may be where you will spend more than a few hours. Make sure everything is in good shape and ready to go.
