LIFEGUARD ACADEMY

Before the Summer Peak Season starts, the City of Corpus Christi Beach Rescue trains a group of lifeguard candidates, or “rookies,” during the Lifeguard Academy. The academy uses the curriculum of the United States Lifesaving Association. Lifesaving skills are learned in the classroom environment and the open water of the Gulf of Mexico.

The course consists of 40 hours of training, including the American Red Cross CPR/First Aid certification, United States Lifesaving Association Open Water Lifeguard Training, public social interaction training, and physical training.

Lifeguard candidates will be paid for training and are expected to bring their own swimsuits and will be given a rookie shirt to wear during the academy. Upon successful completion of the Lifeguard Academy, candidates will be issued their Lifeguard uniform and be eligible to work for the City of Corpus Christi Beach Rescue.

SWIM PRACTICE

Interested applicants are encouraged to utilize the Corpus Christi ISD Natatorium on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to practice their swimming skills from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. before attending a tryout session, although it is not required.
