Did you know that World Migratory Bird Day is celebrated twice a year? Visit the Preserve on this year's fall date, October 12, as we celebrate Texas's own "frequent fliers" – not just birds, but bugs and bats too!

- This event is for all ages. Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Activities include:
 - **Guided Nature Walk:** Frequent Fliers
 - **Meet Us on the Trail:** Learn how to use a butterfly net and view bugs up close or explore how birds use their beaks and touch replica bird skulls.
 - **Crafts:** Make your own bird glider or bat mask.
 - **Sign out a pair of binoculars** at the Learning Center and take them on the trail, along with your very own mini birding journal.
