Dr. Humberto Perotto – Associate Professor and Research Scientist

Invasive grasses are a problem across the globe. In the Coastal Bend, the invasive guinea grass is a problem. How it alters the landscape, which in turn can affect wildlife, is the focus of Dr. Perotto's work. He teaches Landscape Ecology at the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute, a research facility at Texas A&M University-Kingsville. In order to understand these large-scale and small-scale changes in the landscape, Dr. Perotto utilizes drones, remote sensing and geographic information systems. Join us to learn more about the work being done to understand the effect of invasive species in South Texas Rangelands.
