In this class, we will make beautiful Christmas stockings from scraps or small pieces of holiday fabrics. This is a quick, easy project that makes a wonderful decoration or Christmas gift for that special someone. Participants will need to bring their sewing machine, basic sewing tools, thread, scissors (or small cutting mat and cutter), and the supplies listed below.

- 1. You will need approximately one yard of fabric, in the following breakdown; 1 fat quarter, or at least a 12" x 19" piece of coordinating fabric (for the back), 1/3 yard, or a 12" x 40" strip of fabric (for the lining), enough scraps of Christmas fabric to cover a 12" x 19" rectangle when stitched together.
- 2. May use optional embellishments such as lace, ribbon, large pom-poms, small ornaments, felt shapes, or bells.

Additional notes:

- It is better to have extra scraps for the front, so you can move them around and play with the layout a bit.
- Two ironing stations will be available, so if you have a portable iron and pad, bring it along.
- · Patterns will be handed out during the class.
