## Camping Fees:

\$28 for up to three days of camping; and \$28 for up to three *additional* days. RV Campsite fee: \$55 for up to three days of camping; and \$55 for up to three *additional* days. Overnight camping is allowed by City ordinance for a maximum of six consecutive days. Only two (2) campsite parking permits are included with each campsite. Each campsite will include parking permits for two vehicles. Each additional vehicle will need a \$3 per day permit to enter the park; or a \$6 weekend pass per vehicle may be purchased upon park entry.
