Storm Surge

Storm surge is water pushed ashore by the winds of a tropical cyclone. It has caused more fatalities than any other hurricane hazard.



High Winds

Winds from a hurricane are 74 mph or greater and can cause massive damage to buildings and structures in its path.

Flooding
Inland flooding is the most frequent cause of hurricane fatalities since it can occur far from the coast and long after landfall.



Tornadoes

Tornadoes are commonly spawned by a hurricane and can cause damage far away from the center of the storm.
