### Construction Updates

#### Bonner Intersection Open!

By close of business on Friday, December 20, crews will open up the intersection of Bonner Drive and Everhart Road.

The City encourages residents to use Corona Drive and Williams Drive as they travel during the holiday season, as contractors continue to work on installing a 30" wastewater line on Everhart Road between Bonner Drive and Cain Drive.



All work is weather permitting.

#### Closures included:

- Northbound and Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue as one lane for both directions.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road, left turns will continue to be allowed at the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the project.
